### About

In November 2018, the Town of Halton Hills began developing an Active Transportation Master Plan (ATMP). Active transportation is defined as any kind of transportation using one's own physical body to get from one place to another. The intent of the ATMP is to prioritize active transportation alternatives to help achieve the Town's climate, growth and financial targets. The ATMP will:

1. Identify a network of continuous and connected routes made up of on and off-road facilities that prioritize safety and consider a range of users;
2. Strengthen the Town's integrated transportation system to achieve the benefits of multi-modal travel and first-last mile active travel;
3. Accommodate varying trip types and purposes by linking key destinations such as schools, community centres and future mobility hubs; and
4. Provide support for long-term implementation, monitoring, maintenance and promotion of the active transportation network.

A review has been conducted to identify locations where active transportation corridors could be implemented within the short-term.

### Process & Engagement

The Town has engaged with residents and stakeholders through different consultation events since March 2019. A second round of engagement in the form of an online interactive, open house style drop in session will be held to:

- Review and confirm the proposed active transportation routes and facilities as well as associated phasing including short, medium and long-term priorities;
- Determine a preferred approach for public promotion and outreach to encourage greater ATMP use; and
- Establish buy-in to the recommendations and strategies identified as part of the ATMP document.
